Birthday Treats at School
Rules and Procedures

Bringing treats for classmates on your birthday is a common practice in many schools. This practice is voluntary and participation is optional. Normally treats are brought on the child's birthday or the day that school is in session close to the child's birthday. Students with summer birthdays may select another day during the school year to bring treats if so desired. Parents are asked to notify the teacher at least one day prior to bringing treats.

The following rules and procedures apply to bring treats:

- Treats must be store bought and individually wrapped.
- Treats must be no larger than one serving portion per individual.
- Students should bring enough treats so that each student in the class and the teacher receives a treat.
- The following items are not allowed:
 - Pop
 - Drinks
 - Cupcakes from a bakery/store
 - Cakes from a bakery/store
- Treats will be distributed as directed by the classroom teacher.
